Methodists have been meeting regularly in Middlezoy since 1807. John Wesley preached in the parish several times between 1744 and 1766. The current chapel was built in 1898, with seats for 154.

Inside the chapel, is an accessible flexible space. We are available for Baptisms, Weddings and Funerals.

There are 2 services each month; the 2nd Sunday of the month is a United Service with Holy Cross. The 4th Sunday of the month is our Circuit service which includes Holy

Communion. We liaise with Holy Cross over special services and events, and work together to offer seasonal Family Fun half-days for all ages.

We hold a monthly community lunch, soup and sweets in the winter, salads and sweets in the summer.

On Friday mornings in term time, the 'Peekaboo Gang' babies and toddler group is held between 9.30 and 12.00

A recent venture on 'Sunny Saturday mornings' is a Pop Up Café, with the Village Shop,

We can offer a community space for the Village Coffee Morning, Pilates, Band rehearsals, and various meetings.

MIDDLEZOY WEEKLY COFFEE MORNING

A coffee morning is held every Monday (excluding bank holidays) from 10am - 11.45 at the Methodist Chapel in the village. This is next to the community shop on church road.

It is well attended mainly by residents of the village (often 25-30 persons). Tea/Coffee/Hot Chocolate is available at a cost of £1 with free refills. The event is run by volunteers and if you would like to help you can ask to be added to the rota.

There is a raffle every week and we have a bric a brac stall. Anything we do not sell after a few weeks is taken to a local charity shop. There is a room at the back of the chapel that is full of many different types of books and jigsaws to buy at a very low cost. Come along and have a peruse.

As we get near Easter and Christmas

we invite local crafters to come along and have a stall at the coffee morning. These are well received and offers the opportunity to find that unique gift.

Our costs are rental of the chapel , insurance and supplies. These are minimal so as we are not a profit making organisation, we often hold the raffle for a charity and at christmas we donate to local clubs/groups. We aim to give back monies we receive to the community.

We welcome visitors to the coffee morning as well as any new residents. Everyone is welcome. Come along for a chat and a cuppa and meet some new friends.

MIDDLEZOY WOMEN'S SOCIAL CLUB



Middlezoy Women's Social Club was formed over 90 years ago. It is currently made up of 14 members aged from 40-80 years and live in the village.

The purpose of the group is to raise funds during the year to be able to fund a coach for a summer outing and provide a christmas party for the senior citizens of the village. Invitations to these events are delivered to your home.

We also occasionally run events for charity - in particular the MacMillan BIG Coffee Morning every year.

We meet approx 6 times a year in someone's house for a meeting. We have a couple of social events for

the group during the year - usually a christmas meal (in the new year) and maybe an afternoon tea.

To raise funds we usually run a Brunch once or twice a year where we sell breakfast baps. Look out for posters and the village facebook page advertising our events. We take the opportunity to run a tombola when there is a village fete. We are fortunate that we do receive donations during the year which also boosts our funds.

During the summer months we have a stall (Lottie) where allotmenters and villagers can donate excess crops. Any money raised goes to the day to day running of the allotments

Together with the allotments, we have apple trees and beehives on site, and Wild Middlezoy have two plots which are being developed more as a community facility which will include access for disabled people.

We are a friendly bunch and we try to help one another out, such as when new fence posts are required and other difficult tasks. We hold a barbeque each summer on the allotment site which is a fun occasion for all.

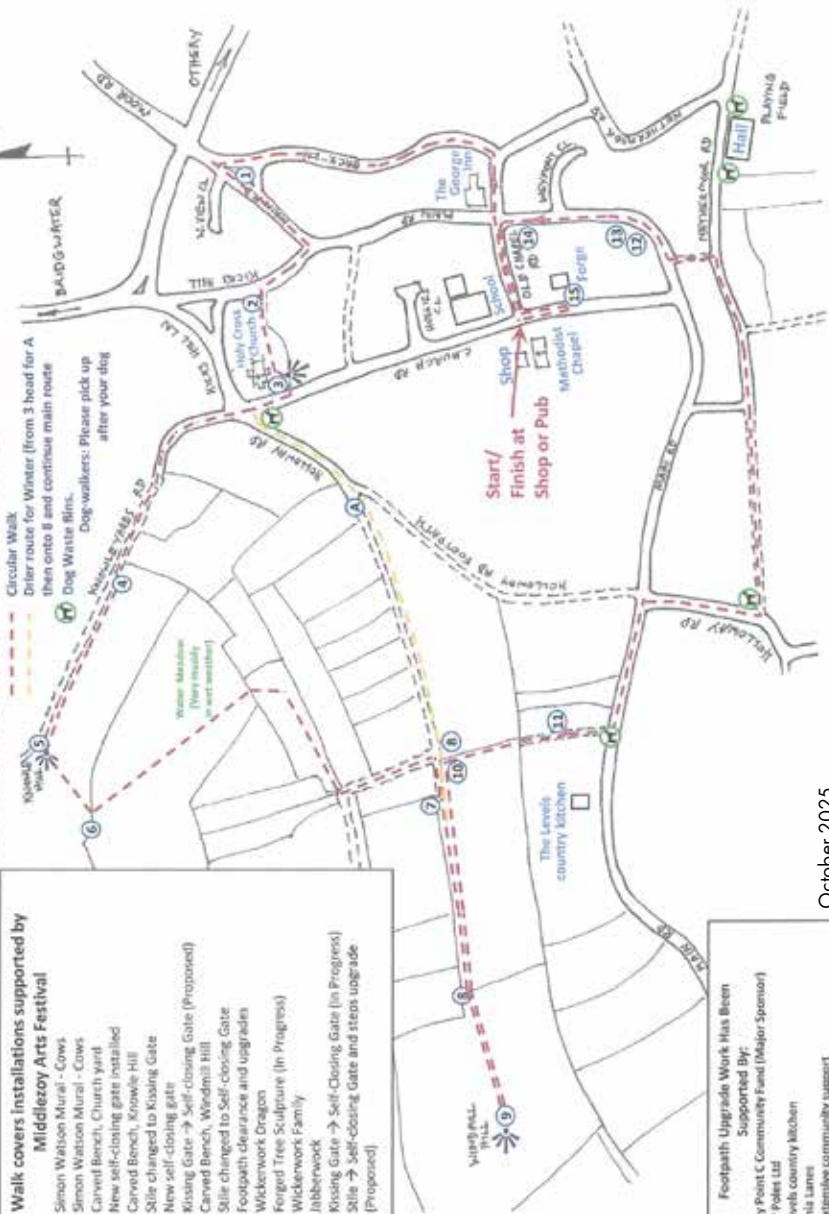
